



The **Clinical Investigation Unit** conducts phase I,II and III vaccines clinical trials sponsored by the world's leading vaccines producers. It provides **ImmuneHealth** with the necessary tools to design, organize and conduct clinical and epidemiological studies as part of its own research development programs in the field of vaccinology / immunology.

The Clinical Investigation Unit operates according to ICH-GCP standards and the May 7, 2004 Belgian law concerning experiments on the human person. It is staffed with highly skilled physicians and nurses experienced in clinical trials and with an expertise in infectious diseases, vaccination and epidemiologic methods.

To guarantee the highest standards of security for the trials subjects, the Clinical Investigation Unit is based in a large university affiliated hospital, the **Centre Hospitalo-Universitaire Tivoli** located in La Louvière, Belgium at about 20 km of the Aeropole of Charleroi. This allows easy access to medical care if needed. The dedicated 150m² facility includes a comfortable waiting room, clinic visit space, a laboratory equipped with validated tools allowing to handle and store biologic samples as well as investigational products under constantly monitored temperature, and office space.

To meet the requirement for enrollment in clinical trials, the Clinical Investigation Units has an active communication program with health care providers, and with the community. As a result it maintains contact with a large number of healthy volunteers.
